1.Venue

Fukuoka International Congress Center

•The Fukuoka Convention Center is an affiliated organization of Fukuoka City and was established in 1979.

At present their foundation manages three facilities; Fukuoka International Congress Center (FICC),

Marinemesse Fukuoka and Fukuoka Kokusai Center as "Convention Zone".

•This convention zone is conveniently located within 5km of Hakata railway station and Fukuoka airport.

By taxy it typically takes about 15 to 20 min from airport. Hakata Port International Terminal is next to

this zone.

•FICC was built 16 years ago. This facility can accommodate about 5,000 people. There are 24 conference rooms.

rooms and a parking lot outside of this building. Over 1,000 events are held at FICC every year.

•A passage way also connects the facility to the Fukuoka Sunpalace Hotel & Hall. These two facilities become one unit in order to accommodate a large scale conference.






International Accessibility
